

Secondhand Prose accepts donations of books, movies and music and is a 501 (C) (3) organization so your donations are tax deductible if that applies to you.



Friends of the Quincy Public Library have been in existence since the 1960's. Originally, the group formed to support the Library through volunteers. Later, the group began having book sales so that when a space became available in the Library, they would have the funds necessary to operate a business. The FOL continued to provide volunteer service through many activities held within the Library. The FOL dreams were answered in 2012 when the Library completed a major renovation of the entire library space which included a beautiful space for the sale of used books. The proceeds from the sale are used to support programs and services that the Library has not included in their regular taxpayer funded budget. Since 2012, the FOL have contributed in excess of a whopping \$300,000! All of the money raised comes from the sale of books at the store and two book sales each year. Since we opened our doors, we have been selling paperbacks for \$1.00 and hardbacks for \$3.00. And books sell for 50 cents per inch at our book sales. That's a lot of books sold!
